Isaiah 2.1-22: *Because GOD is Covenant Creator learn in his light how to evaluate everyone and everything*

ONE: Because of GOD's covenant plan let him light up your life. 2.1-5

TWO: When GOD's people reject him he greases their tracks for he alone will be exalted. 2.5-11

THREE: On GOD's chosen day his exalted presence will bring low all that is lifted up. 2.12-19

FOUR: At the terror and splendor of GOD's presence we will cast away our idols and not trust the breath of man. 2.20-22

Isaiah 3.1-4.6

When we keep glory from God he will remove our glory and renew it only through His Son.

ONE: When God Is Not His People's Support and Supply, He Will Ultimately Remove and Keep Away What Is.
3.1-15

TWO: God Sometimes Takes His People from Riches to Rags Before Sending Them His Rag-tag Savior-Son.
3.16-4.1

THREE: God Doesn't Keep Away His Son, But Sends Him to Cleanse Us By Being Our Shade and Shelter, Our Beautiful & Glorious King.

4.2-6

Interact with Isaiah 3.1-4.6 with these thoughts/questions:

1. Isaiah, Jesus and the Apostles all point to our need for a Savior, but also assume God's salvation produces deeds. If I or someone else who says they have salvation have no zeal and actions for Christ's gospel and kingdom do I/they need to examine themselves and see if they're really in the faith (2Cor 13.5)?
2. God rules over all men and nations but his concern is centered first on his nation/people who are to bless the world. Since God was using Assyria to discipline Israel and Babylon to discipline his Judah and Jerusalem, what men or nations might he be using to discipline his church in America?
