

Justified by Christ's Blood We Rejoice in God!

Series: Seeing **how** Jesus is your salvation will stir your love for him.

Peace with God assures you of the glory of God and enables you to rejoice in the pressures from living for Christ.

ONE: Justification by faith (by blood, by Christ's death) **enables you to stand in the shalom of God.**

¹ Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ. ² Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this **grace in which we stand,**

TWO: Justification by faith (by blood, by Christ's death) **gives you assurance of the glory of God.**

² Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and **we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.**

THREE: Justification by faith and hope of glory enable you to rejoice in the pressures (Rom 8.17) **from living for Christ.**

³ More than that, we **rejoice in our sufferings**, knowing that suffering produces endurance, ⁴ and endurance produces character, and character produces hope,

⁵ and hope does not put us to shame, because **God's love has been poured into our hearts** through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.

⁶ For while we were **still weak**, at the right time Christ died **for the ungodly**. ⁷ For one will scarcely die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person one would dare even to die—⁸ but **God shows his love for us** in that while we were **still sinners, Christ died for us.**

⁹ Since, therefore, we have now been **justified by his blood**, much more shall we be **saved by him from the wrath of God.**

¹⁰ For if **while** we were **enemies** we were **reconciled** to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be **saved by his life.**

A few passages on the glory of God: Psa 19.1; Isa 6.3; Joh 1.14; 2.11; 12.23; 17.4; Mar 13.26; Titus 2.13; 1Jo 3.2; Col 3.4; 2Thes 1.10; Rom 3.23; 8.17, 21.

CONCLUSION: Therefore, rejoice in God through the Lord Jesus Christ.

¹¹ More than that, we also **rejoice in God** through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.
