

**Believing the gospel means. . .**

**I. Turning from self-help to Christ for daily rescue (vv. 6-7).**

**II. Turning from “false gospels” to the gospel of Christ (vv. 8-9).**

**III. Turning from people-pleasing to serving Christ (vs. 10).**

**Questions for Personal or Family Devotions:**

Read Galatians 1:6-10.

1. What is Paul’s gospel that the Galatians are so quickly deserting? What are some practical ways you can remind yourself and others of the gospel regularly?
2. What “false gospel” does the apostle Paul rebuke the Galatians for believing in? What “false gospels” are you tempted to believe when you fail or succeed?
3. Reflect on a recent incident at home, work, school, or neighborhood on which you tempted to rely on yourself instead of the gospel. Reflect on how you could or did live out of the gospel. What impact did or would trusting in the gospel have on the way you handled that incident?
4. How did false teachers malign Paul and his gospel? How have others attempted to undermine your character or integrity as a result of your belief in the gospel?
5. How does believing the gospel help you turn from people-pleasing to serving Christ and those around you?
